






Within Namibia we offer tours including our famous Skeleton Coast, Swakopmund, Damaraland and the desert-adapted elephants, Kaokoland and hot-air

ballooning or hiking the mountainous red dunes of Sossusvlei. Cape Cross Lodge on the desolated desert coastline with its seal colonies is part of our portfolio. Popular coastal activities include shark fishing, sand boarding, desert tours, catamaran trips in Walvis Bay, champagne and oysters at Sandwich Harbour, quad biking in the Namib Desert, camel rides and a variety of extreme or more sedate

activities to choose from.

Tours to Damaraland and Kaokoland, where some of the highlights will be to see the Himba people in their true surroundings, Epupa Falls, the petrified forest and the rock engravings the World heritage site at Twyfelfontein.
