With the support of the European Union, the Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung in partnership with REGAIN TRUST will be implementing a project to address Gender Based Violence in Namibia. The project will commence on 01 May 2018 and it will end in April 2021.

The aim and objectives of this project is to create awareness about gender based violence, prevent and reduce the number of gender based violence cases in Namibia. At the same time the project also aims to empower survivors of gender based violence to find the strength and confidence to get out of abusive relationships.

To reach out to many survivors, branch offices will be opened in Rundu, Keetmanshoop and Walvisbay. Various interventions and activities such as counselling, public dialogue, newspaper articles and studies will be executed to address Gender Based Violence in Namibia.
