## SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

### 1. Rights of Public Entity

Agricultural Bank of Namibia (Agribank) reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

**10. Opening of Quotations**

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in section 9 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the Bidders and the amount, the presence or absence of a Bid-Securing Declaration will be put on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within five working days of the Opening.

**11. Evaluation of Quotations**

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of evaluated cost to determine the lowest evaluated quotation

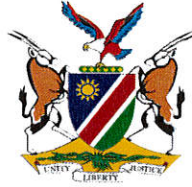
