## FNB AND NIPAM PRESENT TO KEETMANSHOOP MUNICIPALITY

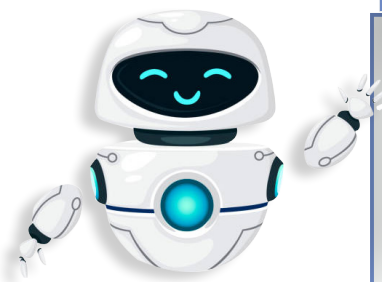
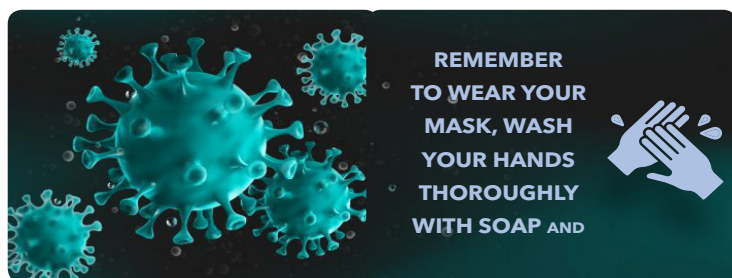
In February 2021, Keetmanshoop Municipality and NIPAM signed a partnership agreement to service (construct bulk municipal services) for 390 plots in two townships (Westdene and Krönlein). Keetmanshoop Municipality foresees to complete the servicing of these plots during the course of 2021. Seven hundred plots are expected to be serviced in 2021 through various projects managed by Keetmanshoop Municipality with the financial assistance of a financial institution.

On Friday 30 April 2021, First National Bank in collaboration with NIPAM made a presentation to Keetmanshoop Municipality for the financing of the partnership agreement. Mr Katoole Ipinge, Ms Vaenesia Siririka and the lead consultant Mr Elifas Luaanda represented NIPAM. Mr Leslie Puriza, Head of Public Sector Banking, Ms Riana Mostert, divisional manager of the south, represented FNB. Councillors and top management from Keetmanshoop Municipality were present to listen to the two presentations. The municipality enquired regarding the term and interest rate, which FNB presented and would deliberate on a decision at a later stage. After the presentation, the three parties went on a site inspection of the two townships to be serviced (Westdene and Krönlein) thereafter they had lunch at a local restaurant. Her worship mayor of Keetmanshoop Municipality Ms Maree Smit thanked NIPAM and FNB for making time to present to their council and hoped for speedy execution of partnership as land delivery was a top priority for Keetmanshoop in 2021.
