## NIPAM AND ASCI SIGN NEW MOU

Administrative Staff College of India Hyderabad of the Republic of India (ASCI) and Namibia Institute of Public Administrative and Public Management signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) on Wednesday 23rd June 2021. The objective of the MoU is to establish a framework for cooperative institutional relations and to promote cooperation in the area of capacity building of the public officials between the two institutions.

The partnership came after NIPAM came to the realization that due to the effects of Covid-19 there was a need to collaborate with international institutions with a similar mandate to NIPAM's. Through the promotion of mutual cooperation in the area of capacity building of public officials, both institutions believe that they can achieve their mandates more efficiently.

The MOU has the collective intent of strengthening technical cooperation between both parties through sharing experiences, best practices and knowledge in the area of capacity building. In addition to this, the MOU will seek to foster a channel through which exchange of knowledge can be had but it will also allow for the creation of a joint organisation of courses, workshops, forums, seminars. The MOU will also seek to create an opportunity for joint participation in research and consultancies activities of common interest.
