## NIPAM OPEN FOR BUSINESS

The Namibia Institute of Public Administration and Management (NIPAM) has once again started to welcome all interested parties to its facilities following the relaxed covid-19 measures.

NIPAM was established as a public institution by an Act of Parliament (Act No. 10 of 2010) to provide training, carry out operational research, deliver consultancies and undertake capacity evaluation initiatives.

NIPAM offers a plethora of training courses, the courses are aimed at assisting the public sector workforce to ensure ongoing professional development while advancing skills and knowledge. NIPAM offers

5 Management Development courses and 43 short courses.

NIPAM offers a variety of venues for hire, with the biggest facility being able to accommodate 300 delegates but keeping in line with Covid-19 regulations a maximum capacity of 100 people can be accommodated. The NIPAM Library services serve as an additional value add to the crop of services on offer. The library operates from Monday to Friday 07:30 – 16:30 with a maximum seating capacity of 40 people.
