## NIPAM LAUNCHED ACCREDITED COURSES



On 25<sup>th</sup> April 2022, the Namibia Institute of Public Administration and Management (NIPAM) expanded its training programmes by launching three new qualifications accredited by the Namibia Qualifications Authority (NQA).

public sector. It is intended to strengthen the capacity of heads of institutions and senior executives in the public sector.

The Certificate in Public Sector Management (NQF level 7) allows trainees to advance their management skills to function effectively at a senior management level in the public sector. This course is targeted at directors and other senior managers in the public sector.

The Certificate in Public Sector Management (NQF level 6) is intended for trainees holding positions at grades 4 to 6 in the Public Service or equivalent in the wider public sector. The programme is designed for mid-level managers and aims to equip them with the relevant knowledge and skills to manage day-to-day operations and systems, improve processes, and develop human capital.

The three NQA accredited courses are: Postgraduate Certificate in Public Sector Management (NQF level 8), Certificate in Public Sector Management (NQF level 7) and the Certificate in Public Sector Management (NQF level 6).

The Certificate in Public Sector Management (NQF level 8) is designed to build stronger capabilities in strategic thinking, innovation and problem solving and is underpinned by powerful, theoretical, practical tools and frameworks for application in the
