NEWLY APPOINTED BOARD MEMBERS OF PUBLIC ENTERPRISES INDUCTED

On 16 and 17 February 2023, the Namibia Institute of Public Administration and Management (NIPAM) and the Ministry of Finance and Public Enterprises (MFPE) jointly provided training to newly appointed Board members from eight (8) Public Enterprises (PEs). The two-day Board induction training aimed at educating the newly appointed Board members on boardroom etiquette, leadership responsibilities, and the Board's role in strategy formulation. They were also inducted on good corporate governance principles and understanding legislation and bylaws.

In addition, this training alerted the Board members of what is expected of them to lead Public Enterprises successfully in line with best practices. It was further highlighted that moving

forward, Boards would be required to focus on accountability, greater Board engagement, Board diversity, and new sustainability-focused regulations on implementing change throughout organisations. This type of training creates a culture of well-informed and engaged Board members, leading to great teamwork, productivity, innovation, and sustainable growth of organisations.

Speaking at the official opening, on behalf of NIPAM's Executive Director, Dr. Butty Salom stated: "The challenges facing our PEs are many and are documented. Among them are non-compliance with the laws governing their operations, inadequate funding, and role conflicts between Management and Board members. Through this training and sound judgment of Board members, these problems will be addressed, and the training aims to address them."

The Executive Director of the Ministry of Finance & Public Enterprises, Mr. Titus Ndove, encouraged Board members to be entrepreneurial and drive their organisations forward. He urged Board members to prioritise being sufficiently knowledgeable about the workings of the PEs and to be answerable for the actions of the PEs while standing back from their day-to-day management.

Eight (8) Boards participated in the induction training, namely Namibia Press Agency (NAMPA), TransNamib Holding, National Fishing Corporation of Namibia (FISHCOR), Epangelo Mining Company, Namibia Statistics Agency (NSA), National Youth Council of Namibia (NYC), National Commission on Research Science and Technology (NCRST), and Namibia National Reinsurance Corporation (NamibRe).
