

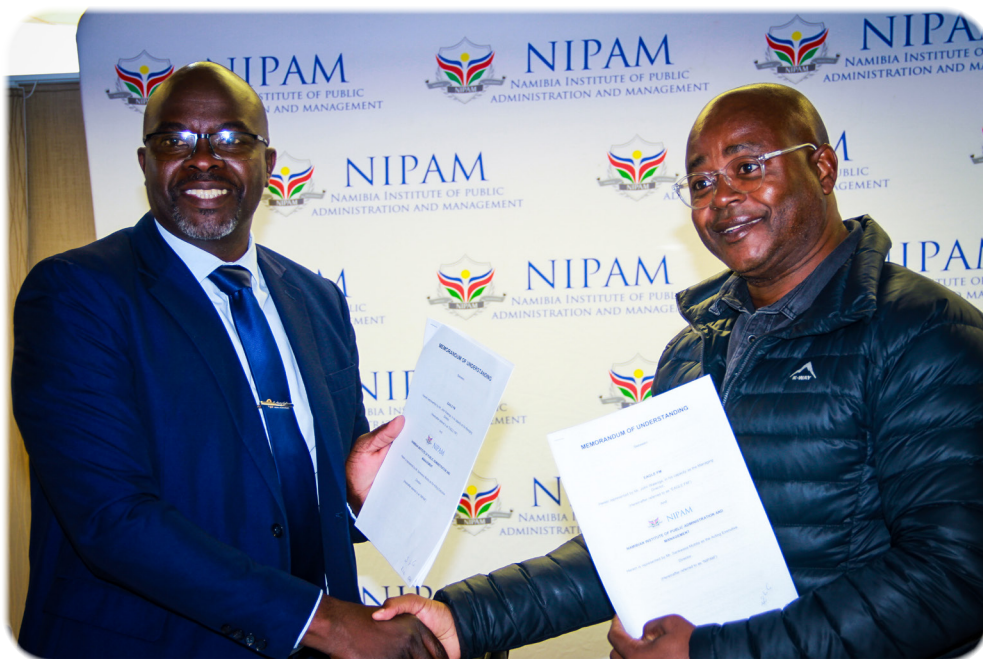

## NIPAM AND EAGLE FM SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)
