## NIPAM AND LUDERITZ TOWN COUNCIL SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)



On Friday, 08 September 2023, The Namibia Institute of Public Administration and Management (NIPAM) signed a five-year Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Lüderitz Town Council. The MoU, which aims to encourage and promote cooperation in areas of training and consultancy, was signed by Hon. Brigitte Fredericks, Deputy Mayor of Lüderitz Town Council, and Mr. Sankwasa Mubita, NIPAM Acting Executive Director at NIPAM Campus.
